- 1. 192 +- deviation of new archers which may be approximately 20 archers.
- 2. For induction into NCOE/KIA, top archers of recurve/ compound event & top archers of Indian round is based on the ranking of commutative points earned in the ranking & elimination round Except archers from NRAT & WNRAT, upon successful completion of age verification test.
- 3. From NRAT/WNRAT top archers will be based on the elimination round ranking upon successful completion of age verification test
- 4. After Removing KIA/Dev. Athletes, from the pool of list created in the above table, their score is to be analysed with the induction benchmark & score progression table (Note 6 of Point 2). If they are at par & above the induction benchmark their rankings will be decided and as per vacancies their induction will happen.
- 5. First priority will be given to Khelo India athletes for induction into NOCE's.
- 6. In exceptional cases we may induct between 14 to 16 years if the concerned archers shows promise in any of the KI tournaments and the coaches of the concerned NCOE approve of the same or the Foreign Coach at the NCOE / appointed recommends the same. Once selected he/she shall follow the career progression norms.

#### Notes:

- 1. **KI : Any archer who has not participated in the last year in** 4 NRATs, Sr/Jr/Sub Junior National Championship/ Selection Trials and his score is lower than the 12th position score of the last National Championship Sr/Jr/Sub Jr will be weeded out.
- 2. **NCOE**: Any archer who has not participated in the last year in 4 NRATs, Sr/Jr/Sub Junior National Championship/ Selection Trials and his scores shall be the lower than the 16th position score of the last National Championship Sr/Jr/Sub Jr will be weeded out.
- 3. An athlete should not be weeded out before 2 years from the date of induction unless in case of any disciplinary issues.
- 4. KIA has to attend both assessment camps compulsorily. If an archer fails to attend any one performance assessment camp then justification is to be submitted for not attending the camp. And, if an archer fails to attend both performance assessment camps, it will lead to weeding out from Khelo India scheme irrespective of his justification & performance as per benchmark.
- 5. Old score progression table is to be used for inductees before 2023. Table is as follows:

- b. Athletes identified from National tournaments as defined in Induction & Weed out protocols.
- c. Athletes Identified from Khelo India Youth games as defined in Induction & Weed out protocols
- d. Athletes Identified from NRAT & WNRAT as defined in Induction & Weed out protocols.

## 6. Selection of NCOE athletes will be done as follows:

- a. Athletes Identified for Khelo India scheme
- b. Waitlisted athletes for Khelo India Scheme
- c. Athletes identified from defined International tournaments in Induction & Weed out protocols irrespective of any age.
- d. Athletes identified for NCOE from defined National tournaments in Induction & Weed out protocols.

- f. Inter SAI
- g. Indian Round
