Criteria for Assessment - Induction / Retention/ Weeding out of KIAs and NCOE athletes:

Assessment -I: PRIMARY ASSESSMENT SCORE

On the basis of the performance points of Khelo India Athletes in the National Ranking Competitions in the last two years, the total points of the two Assessment years (2020 and 2021) will be considered. The total points shall be added to derive cumulative points – This shall be the **Primary Assessment Score**.

Assessment -II: SCORE FROM OTHER ASSESSMENTS

Other Assessment scores include performance in Other domestic non-TTFI tournaments, National Games and Khelo India Youth Games,2021. The below mentioned points shall be allocated for the achievements in these tournaments:

FINAL RANKING LIST: Based on cumulative score of Assessment I and Assessment II

The final ranking list shall be formed based on cumulative score of Assessment I and Assessment II. After calculating the Final Ranking list of all athletes, they would be classified into two separate lists by the High-Performance Manager (HPM) and Talent Identification and Development Committee (TIDC) members:

- 1) Retention List
- 2) Weeding out List

Additionally, any other international achievements by the KIAs in the past 3 years (for this year 2020-2022) shall be taken into consideration while finalizing induction, retention and weeding out. The final list of athletes shall be formed after receiving Inputs/ Recommendations from the TIDC members.







Khelo India Athletes Induction Criteria – Table Tennis (2022)

Assessment

On the basis of the performance points of Athletes in the National Ranking Competitions in the last years (as per TTFI Rank -2021), Vacancy would be filled based on the following percentages:

S.No.	Age Category	Percentage Allocation
1.	U-11	20%
2.	U-13	25%
3.	U-15	25%
4.	U-17	20%
5.	U-19	10%

The ratios of Boys: Girls shall be 1:1. Additionally, exceptional performance of athletes from Men andWomen Category (who are not entitled for any other sponsorships) might be considered for Induction. These above-mentioned percentages would act as a reference for induction and be flexible. In matters of Induction TIDC may take a decision on the final selection of athletes.

FILLING VACANCIES IN NCOE

To fill the vacancies in NCOE Kolkata it was decided by the committee that:

1) The cumulative ranking list prepared after Assessment I and Assessment II shall be used to induct athletes in NCOE Kolkata.
